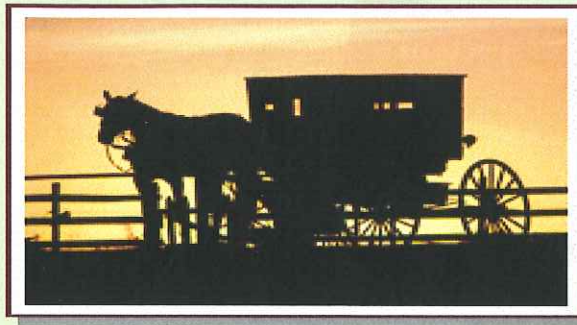

**Day 1 (Thursday):** Leave Elizabethtown at 8:00 a.m. by bus, traveling on to Ohio, with rest stops along the way. After checking in at the Comfort Inn, prepare to depart for the evening dinner theater production of "Waiting for Joshua".

**Day 2 (Friday):** After enjoying a continental breakfast at the hotel, we travel to the Wendell August Forge Workshop and Showroom in Holmes County, where they specialize in hand hammered gifts such as serving bowls, platters, and other items from aluminum, bronze, and pewter. Later, shop at the oldest quilt store in the country where you will find beautiful locally hand quilted items for sale, in addition to a large selection of sewing and quilting accessories. We then continue to a local gourmet store where you will experience a cooking demo featuring pork tenderloin with cranberry sauce. Lunch will be served using the pork tenderloin, along with mashed potatoes, asparagus, and drink, plus a special surprise dessert.

After lunch, visit the beautiful village of Walnut Creek where we make several stops, including a chocolate factory and bakery. During these stops we will get a closer look at the local Amish who make and sell leather purses and other leather items. All through the day, in between the stops, our local tour guide explains in detail about the Amish culture. Later in the afternoon, enjoy a hearty home cooked meal at an Amish homestead. Aromas will fill your senses as you step into the kitchen and smell the piping hot mashed potatoes, baked chicken, roast beef, noodles, vegetables, salad, homemade bread, hot & cold beverages and home-made pies. After the meal, the family will share and possibly sing a song for us before we return to our hotel for the evening.

**Day 3 (Saturday):** Enjoy a continental breakfast at the hotel, and we then depart for a visit further north to Wayne County, where we will encounter a more rustic Amish lifestyle. During our visit there, an Amish woman will be giving basket making demonstrations. There will be a drawing to win one of her baskets. Lunch will then be served at the "Pine Tree Barn" before returning to the hotel for our trip home.
